Vendors invited to the 70th annual Bandon Cranberry Festival

Bandon, OR– Join the longest-running festival on the Oregon Coast. Bandon’s annual Cranberry Festival celebrates it’s 70-year milestone in 2016. Artisans, crafters and food vendors are invited to join the fun on September 10 and 11.

The festival draws the largest attendance of any Bandon community event, with approximately 12,000 residents and visitors in town through the weekend. Cranberry Festival activities and outdoor vendor market areas are centered in Bandon’s Historic Old Town, on the Coquille River waterfront. Vendor booth spaces are reserved for food, beverage, art and hand-crafted products. Booth entries are juried, and the number of entries is limited. Booth prices vary by product type, and electricity is available by advance request.
