CONTEST RULES

Registration, Food Delivery, and Pick-up

1. Participation is free. All entries must be submitted the second Friday in September. Entries are accepted from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. Entries may be delivered by a representative, such as a friend or family member.
2. Contestants must complete a registration form; youth contestants should provide contact information for an adult representative.
3. Recipes must be original, or family “heirloom” recipes; if adapted from a published recipe, contestants must note the source of the recipe.
4. Foods will remain on display through Saturday afternoon. Festival volunteers and judges are NOT responsible for dishes or display items. Food and displays must be picked up between 3 p.m. and 4 p.m. on Saturday; unclaimed items will be discarded or recycled.

Entries and Judging

1. All entries must include a cranberry product, but not necessarily as the main ingredient.
2. Contestants may enter multiple recipes, one item per food category. Previous contest winners are welcome.
3. Contestants younger than age 18 may enter the adult category.
4. There will be no special preparation by judges or festival volunteers. Hot or cold entries may be delivered as close to 1 p.m. as possible.
5. Judging is scheduled from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Friday. All entries are numbered; contestants are anonymous to the judges at time of judging. The identity of the judges will be posted at the time of entry; judges’ decisions are final.
6. Festival organizers and/or judges reserve the right to remove entries deemed unsuitable for the contest.

Winner Responsibilities

The contestant, or a designated representative, must be available to receive the contest award at the Cranberry Coronation Ceremony on Friday, 7 p.m., at the Sprague Community Theater; and ride in the Cranberry Parade, Saturday, beginning at 9 a.m. Winners will be notified by 5 p.m. on Friday, provided with a ticket to the Coronation Ceremony, and directions for parade participation.

All contestants are invited to submit recipes for possible publication by the Bandon Chamber of Commerce. Winners earn an honorary title and ribbon; there are no cash prizes.
