



BANDON CRANBERRY FESTIVAL NONPROFIT INVITATION

The Bandon Oregon Chamber of Commerce is pleased to host the Bandon Cranberry Festival. Our annual Cranberry festival, one of the longest-running festivals on the Oregon Coast, started in 1947 and has been hosted by the Bandon Chamber since 1997. The Annual Cranberry Festival is two full days and draws the largest attendance of any Bandon community event with thousands of residents and visitors in town through the weekend.

EVENT DATES AND TIMES:

The Cranberry Festival invites vendors to join the festival the second weekend in September. Festival market hours are 11 am to 6 pm, Saturday and 10 am to 4 pm, Sunday.

PROTOCOL:

The protocol for nonprofit organization participation in the Bandon Cranberry Festival is as follows:

- Your organization is responsible for the set-up, take down, and operation of your booth. There is no charge for your booth space.
- You must provide a youth/family friendly activity. Activities may be simple games or crafts.
- You may charge a nominal fee for your activity. If you have a game or contest, a small prize must be provided. Prizes may be something as small as a piece of candy.
- You may have a raffle in addition to the activity. We encourage you to have literature to explain your organization to the public. You may sell promotional materials.
- Selling food and beverages is not an option. Nonprofit organizations wishing to sell food and/or beverage products must apply for a food and beverage vendor space.
- Defamation of other organizations or individuals is prohibited. Partisan and political materials and/or otherwise negative materials are prohibited.
- Your booth must be supervised at all times during market hours.

REGISTRATION:

The nonprofit application deadline is May 15. For priority consideration, we encourage you to return the following application form as early as possible. The Chamber will not finalize your application until we have received all the following items: both pages of the registration form, including a signed "Participation and Hold Harmless Agreement," current Health Department certification, if necessary, and proof of liability insurance. (A rider to your liability insurance naming the Bandon Chamber of Commerce and the City of Bandon as additional insured will suffice.)

BANDON CRANBERRY FESTIVAL APPLICATION TERMS OF ENTRY



TERMS OF ENTRY FOR ALL VENDORS

- Cranberry Festival activities and the Vendor Markets will be located in Bandon Old Town.
- There is no overnight camping. Please contact local RV parks and motels for reservations.
- There is no onsite overnight parking available on the Cranberry Festival property. VENDORS must remove all vehicles from the Cranberry Festival property by 9 am Saturday.
- VENDOR must provide their own tent and display furniture.
- No early takedowns. If you take down early, you will not be invited to future Festivals.
- The Cranberry Festival may experience coastal fog, rain, and wind. Bring something to cover your items.
- Vendor spaces may be on asphalt, and afternoon winds may occur. Hence, we require a properly weighted tent. Tent weights strapped to each leg or heavy weights that slide over each leg are great options. 40 lbs. per leg is a great rule-of-thumb at any outdoor venue.
- All belongings must be inside your tent at night, covered and secured. We recommend zippered tent sides!
- The Cranberry Festival provides overnight patrols on Friday and Saturday nights. We do not guarantee your booth will be free from theft or damage.
- Cranberry Festival does not allow pets in your booth. (Service dogs excepted.)
- Cranberry Festival requires VENDOR to monitor and keep their space clean of spills and trash.
- The Cranberry Festival Committee reserves the right to prohibit the sale or distribution of merchandise that has the potential to create a nuisance, such as string-shooters, bomb bags, or water guns.
- Cranberry Festival does not permit the sale or raffle of firearms and controlled-substance paraphernalia.
- By participating, VENDOR authorizes any party to produce videos, take pictures, and record sound in connection with promotion of the Cranberry Festival. Further, VENDOR assigns and transfers their right for use and publishing electronically or in print.
- VENDOR agrees to use space as described and stay within their assigned space. Vendor spaces are assigned prior to arrival. All space assignments are final.
- VENDOR agrees to accept space assigned and will not sublet to anyone else.
- VENDOR will dump trash in approved containers only.
- VENDOR must clean up their own garbage at the end of the event. Dumpsters are available. VENDORS who do not clean up their booth space will not be invited to future Festivals.
- VENDOR is responsible for electrical cords with pigtails, licenses, fees, insurance, and if required, meeting appropriate Health Department regulations.
